Fukushima – Olympic Games Tokyo 2020

Dear Dr. Rosen,

Thank you for your recent letter addressed to International Olympic Committee (IOC) President Thomas Bach, who asked us to respond to you.

We have taken note of the points raised in your letter. The health and safety of the athletes and participants at the Olympic Games is a top priority for the IOC and as the body responsible for overseeing the Olympic Games Tokyo 2020, we can assure you that we will do our utmost, in cooperation with the relevant authorities, to ensure that those attending the Games can do so in a safe and secure environment.

To that effect we are kept regularly updated on this topic by the Japanese authorities, through the Tokyo 2020 Organising Committee, during our on-site visits to Tokyo and through our multiple exchanges.

However, on the wider issue of Fukushima, we would suggest that you contact the relevant Japanese authorities, who would be better placed to discuss this subject with you.

We thank you once again for drawing attention to this important issue and appreciate your concern for the welfare of all those involved in the staging of the Olympic Games Tokyo 2020.
